## Welcome Furniture staff in Caernarfon assemble to upgrade their IT skills



Welcome Furniture manufacture bedroom furniture in Caernarfon, employing 150 staff including 15 in the office.

When the IT manager, Colin Pearce, was looking to increase the skills of office staff there he contacted WEA Cymru.

Colin said "I was looking on the internet for an IT course that would suit our company as we were looking to increase the skills levels of our staff.

I contacted WEA Cymru and discussed our requirements. Tudur Evans from the Workplace team explained how the Essential Skills in the Workplace project could help, this was interesting as it provided the staff training we needed free of charge.

"The course has been very beneficial for the company and I have noticed a significant drop in calls for help with IT problems since the staff started.

They are now able to work independently using software such as Excel and Word without calling for assistance.

There's the added benefit that they will have a qualification at the end too."

Diane Williams, who works in the home deliveries department, said "it has been good to learn more about what the software can do, I used Excel in a very basic way before and didn't realise all the other things I could do with it.

I've also been learning how to present my work, using different fonts, integrating photographs, graphs and spreadsheets which I didn't realise I could do".

Rachel Williams, Officer Supervisor commented "before the course I had no experience of using Excel, but now I feel I know a lot more about it and its good training for the future."

Colin added "Rob Sanderson, the tutor, has been very helpful and arranged the classes to take place at a time that is convenient to us. We shut the factory on a Friday afternoon anyway so Rob comes in then."

Rob said "I am very pleased with the way the staff at Welcome Furniture responded to the course, they have worked hard on their projects and all have progressed to a higher level than they were at when they started."
