- **Established in 1992**
- **69 National Centers in 35 countries**
- **Mostly hosted under Ministries of Education or Employment**
- **Financing:**
EU funding (Erasmus+) and national contribution
(often 50%-50%)
- **Exchange and cooperation between guidance services**
- **2 network meetings / year**
- **Steering Committee + 3 Europe-wide EG working groups**

Competence development of the guidance community on the European dimension in guidance

- a) Support the development of the European dimension in lifelong guidance within national guidance systems**
 - through strategic cooperation with relevant national and EU authorities, services and networks
 - through information sharing, peer learning and facilitating international exchange and cooperation in the area of lifelong guidance

- a) Support the competence development of guidance practitioners and raise their knowledge and awareness on the value of international mobility for careers and skills development**
 - through training and other learning opportunities
 - through strategic dissemination and communication

c) Provide information and communication on:

- the European dimension of guidance (e.g. guidance systems)
- Information and tools to support mobility in Europe (e.g. guidance services, exchanges & grants, learning opportunities)
- the role and function of the Euroguidance network and centres

- results of EU funded projects, events, peer learning activities and network activities
- innovative practices, research and development of guidance services to support mobility in Europe
