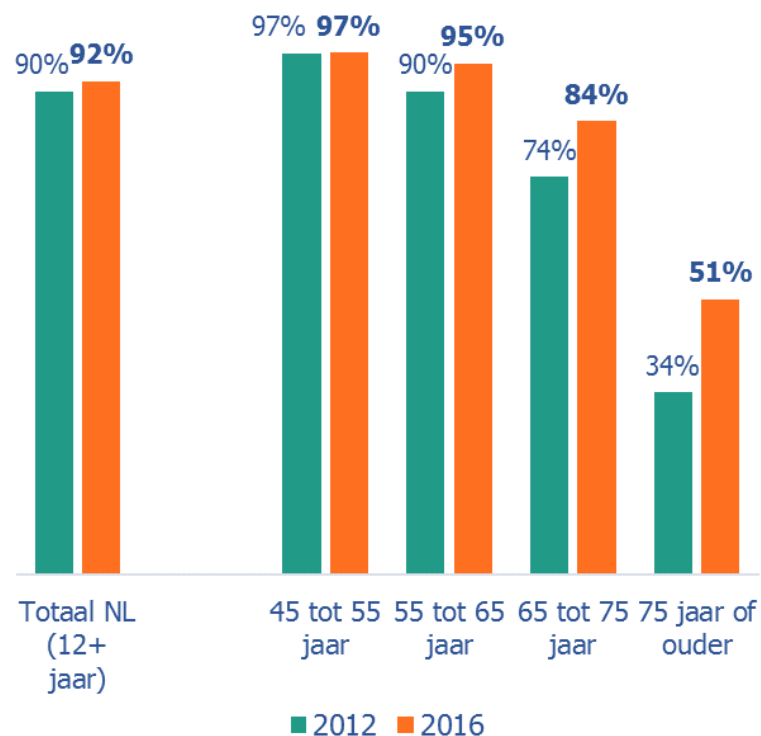

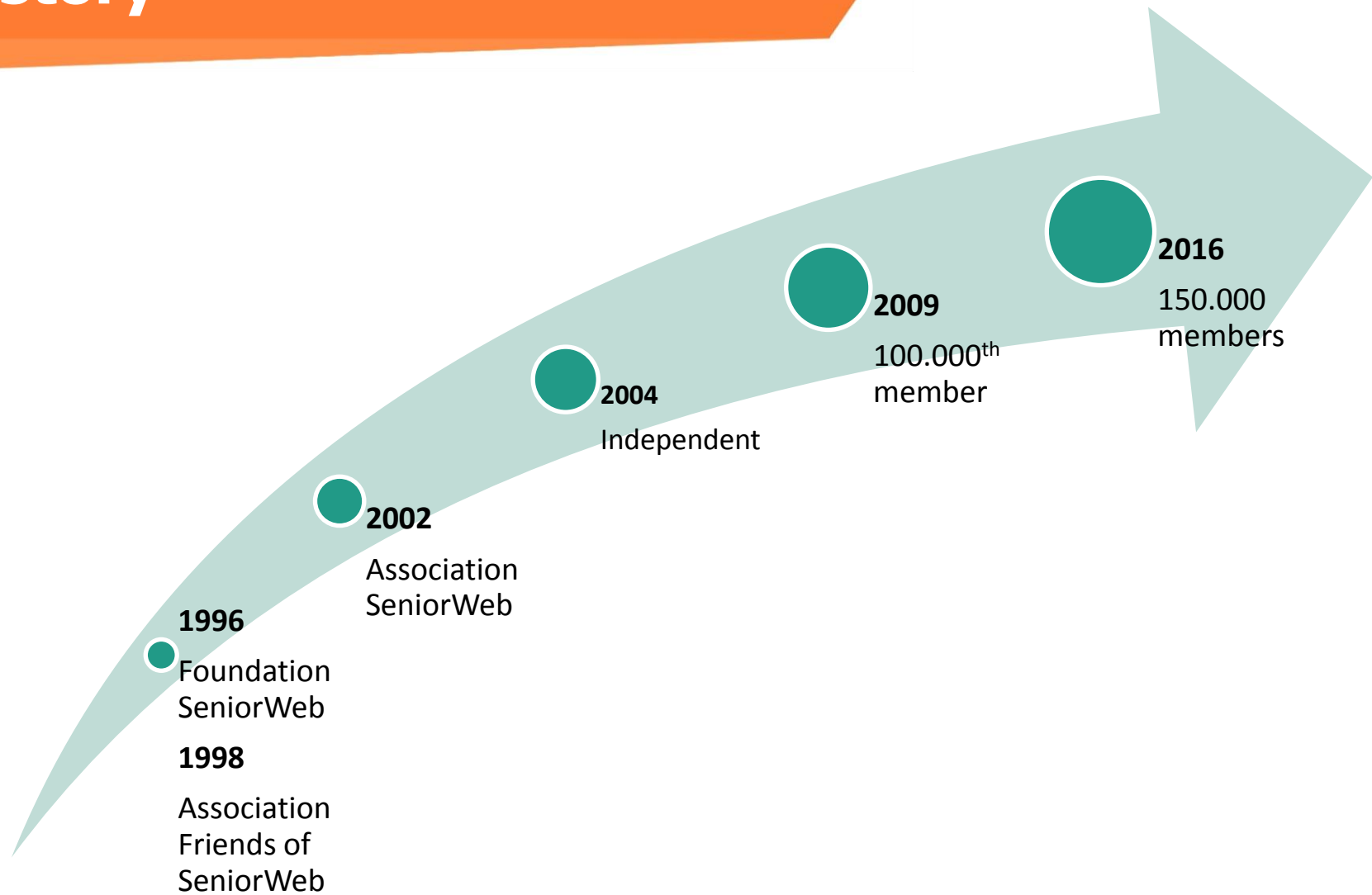
Mission

Vision

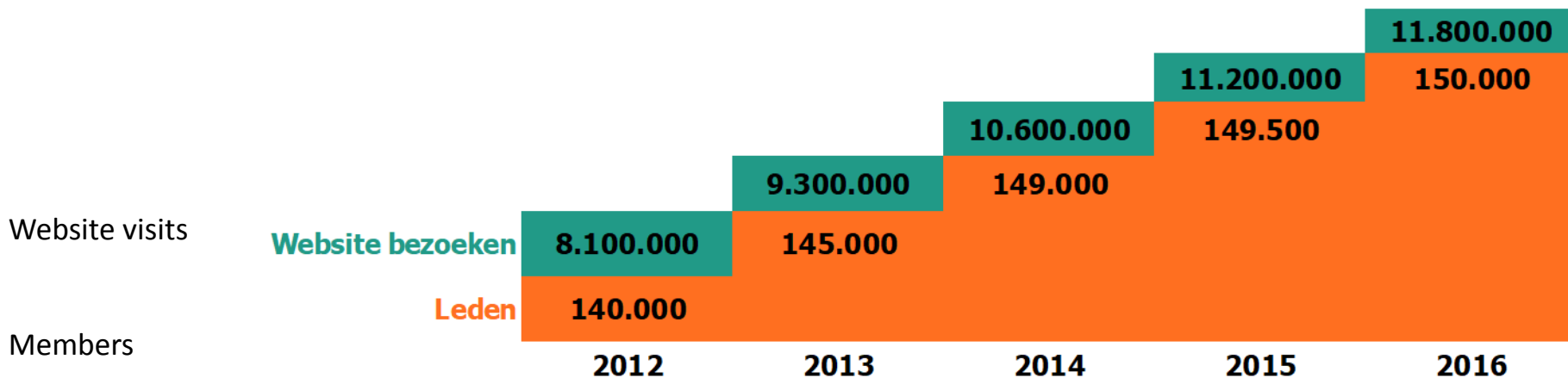
SeniorWeb believes that the digital society is an essential part of, and offers an enrichment for, the daily life of a senior citizen.

Organisation

- Member Council (35 members)
- Board (7 members)
- Head office (30 employees)
- Ambassadors (3.000 volunteers)
- Members (150.000 members)



Domain

Digital developments (devices/software/internet/applications) that have impact on the daily life of senior citizens in different ways:

- Social - in touch
- Psychological – up-to-date, in the lead
- Financial/economical – beneficial; government
- Health – e-health
- Living – Home automation
- Personal interests - hobbies, entertainment

- Newsletters

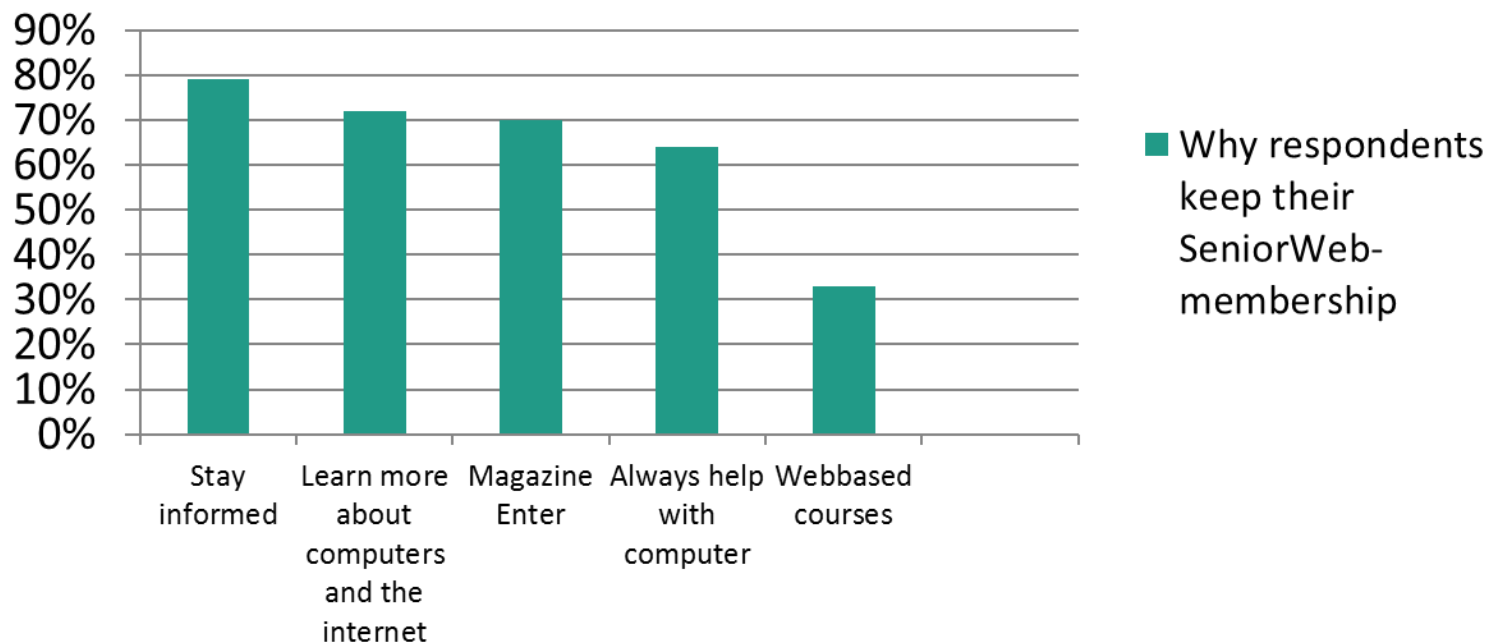

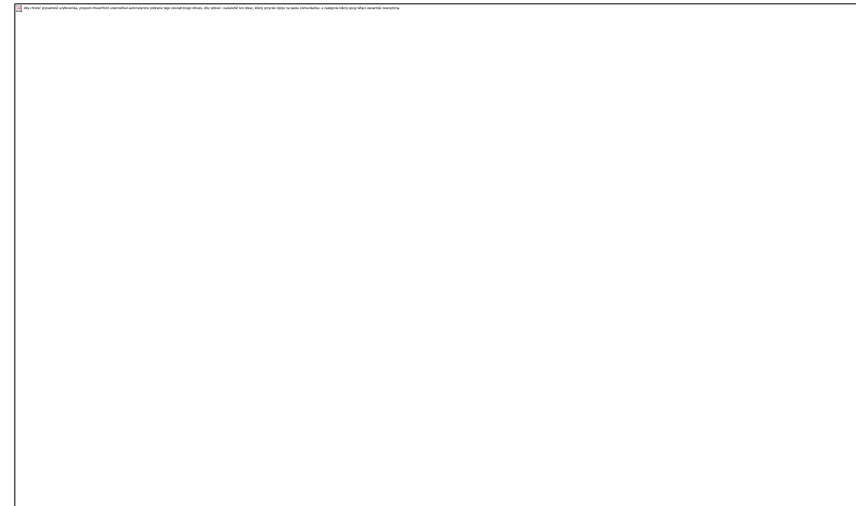
Learning Centres

- Courses and workshops
- At 425 locations in the Netherlands
- For beginners and advanced
- Approachable: understandable and affordable
- Teachers are seniors and volunteers of SeniorWeb
- Accessible for everyone, you don't have to be a member



3 PCHelp services (55.000 requests a year):

- PCHelp by telephone
 - Remote PCHelp (Teamviewer)
- PCHelp at home
- PCHelp via internet



Ratings PCHelp (Membership research 2015 – 3.376 respondents)

PCHelp at home:	8,1	(highest score out of 10 same as Magazine Enter)
Remote PCHelp:	8,0	
PCHelp via internet:	7,7	
PCHelp by telephone:	7,6	

PCHelp by telephone

At PCHelp by telephone, volunteers solve computerproblems of SeniorWeb-members by phone.

- Open on working days from 9.00-12.00 AM on a servicenumber.
- Volunteers work at home with online callcentersoftware
- About 50 volunteers, 1 morning a week, 10 volunteers per day
- 2015: about 15.000 calls



Remote PCHelp

For remote PCHelp the volunteers help the SeniorWeb-member with Teamviewer or Quick-Assist while being on the phone with them.

- The appointment is a result of call with PCHelp by Telephone
- Volunteers work at home with online callcentersoftware
- About 10 volunteers, about 3 appointments p/day p/week
- 2015: about 877 appointments



PCHelp at Home

PCHelp at Home volunteers make an appointment with SeniorWeb members at home.

- A regional co-ordinator is responsible for the distribution of requests
- Nationally divided in 7 regions, every region has 2 co-ordinators
- About 350 volunteers
- 2015: about 9500 requests



PCHelp via internet

PCHelp via internet volunteers answer online questions of members.

- Members can ask questions online for free
- Volunteers can answer questions by choice
- About 30 volunteers
- 2015: almost 30.000 questions



Does it work?

Yes! SeniorWeb: active for 21 years.

- **425** SeniorWeb-Learning Centres
- **3.000** volunteers (50+)
- **150.000** members
- **705.000** educated senior citizens
- **58.000** requests for computerhelp a year
- **11,8 million visits a year** on our website
