Scaffolding – start where people are at (colour-blindness/binary divisions) and ease people into the topic. e.g. my own decision to talk about my own privilege.


Modelling – normalize the topic/make it unremarkable. e.g NM.



Build community (safety, solidarity, significance) e.g. participatory methods.

Racism and Privilege

- Racism and Privilege are 2 sides of the same coin.
- If Racism is a system of disadvantage then it follows that there are a group of people who are "advantaged."
- It is only logical to concentrate on both groups.
- What to do:
- L- Listen and reflect
- A Acknowledge and Educate
- A Act: Call it out!
